


“Details of syllabus for BA (Hons.) in Modern European Languages, Literatures and Cultures (French/German/Italian/Russian) under the Centre for Modern European Languages, Literatures and Cultural Studies

Course Structure:

- Course I: Specialized Study of the Language I
(French / German / Italian / Russian)**
- Course II: Structural Study of Language II
(French / German / Italian / Russian)**
- Course III: History, Cultures, Philosophies and Ideas of Europe I
(Antiquity to Reformation)**
- Course IV: History, Cultures, Philosophies and Ideas of Europe II
(Reformation to the present day)**
- Course V: Advanced Study of Language
(French / German / Italian / Russian)**
- Course VI: Translation
(Introduction to Theories and Practical Translation)**
- Course VII: Introduction to Literature I: History of Literature
of the Language of Specialization**
- Course VIII: Introduction to Literature II: Specialized Study of
any two Authors of the Language of Specialization**

Note:

- Courses I, II, V, VI, VII and VIII will be in the language of specialization, i.e. the students can opt for *specialization in any one of the four languages* currently being offered (French, German, Italian or Russian).
- Courses III and IV will be *common Courses*, i.e. all Honours students of CMELLCS will have to take these courses. The medium of instruction is English in Course III and IV.
- In accordance with Visva-Bharati regulations and/or UGC guidelines, all students of CMELLCS will have to take *General and Subsidiary* (related subjects) courses for the stipulated period and duration.
- Students will answer examinations in Courses I, II, V, VI, VII and VIII in the language of specialization only.
- Students will answer all examinations in Courses III and IV in English.
- Each Course (Courses I to VIII) carries marks of 50 in each semester (10 for Internal Assessment and 40 in the end semester written examination).




The distribution of the Courses over six semesters (three years) shall be as follows:

Semester III:	Course II (Part 1):	Structural Study of the Language I (French / German / Italian / Russian)
	Course IV (Part 1):	History, Cultures, Philosophies and Ideas of Europe II (Part 1: Reformation to Enlightenment)
Semester IV:	Course II (Part 2):	Structural Study of the Language II (French / German / Italian / Russian)
	Course IV (Part 2):	History, Cultures, Philosophies and Ideas of Europe II (Part 2: Enlightenment to the Present Day)
Semester V:	Course V (Part 1):	Advanced Study of Language (1) (French / German / Italian / Russian)
	Course VI (Part 1):	Translation I (Introduction to Theories and Practical Translation)
	Course VII (Part 1):	History of Literature (Antiquity to Enlightenment)
	Course VIII (Part 1):	Specialized Study of Authors (1)
Semester VI:	Course V (Part 2):	Advanced Language Studies (2) (French / German / Italian / Russian)
	Course VI (Part 2):	Translation II (Introduction to Theories and Practical Translation)
	Course VII (Part 2):	History of Literature (Enlightenment to the Present Day)
	Course VIII (Part 2):	Specialized Study of Authors (2)

The eligibility criteria for admission to the course is 60% in aggregate in Higher Secondary or equivalent examination and 60% in English at HS or equivalent level. Students do not require any prior knowledge in French/German/Italian/Russian as these languages will be taught from the zero level.

At the end of the third year students will be awarded the degree of BA (Hons.) in Modern European Languages, Literatures and Cultures (French/German/Italian/Russian) as per their specialization in the language and culture of their choice."
