In May 1951, Visva-Bharati was declared to be a Central University and "An Institution of National Importance" by an Act of Parliament. It was granted the status of a unitary, teaching and residential university. From the very beginning Rabindranath tried to foster a selfsufficient social life along with new values of creative as well as participatory culture. Visva-Bharati has two campuses Santiniketan and Sriniketan oriented to theoretical and practical learning respectively.

About Centre for Mathematics Education:

The Centre for Mathematics Education was established in 1999. The Centre organizes Seminars/ Symposia/ Workshops/ Extension Activities/ Research Guidance etc. concerning various aspects of Mathematics Education such as curricula development, material development, writing of good text books in Mathematics for the school students of Visva-Bharati. The centre has also a plan to offer a course on Post-Graduate diploma in Mathematics Education.

Location and Climate:

Visva-Bharati is ensconced in a rural setting in the district of Birbhum, about 160 km by road from Kolkata. The nearest railway station is Bolpur (Santiniketan) on the Eastern Railway and the air-terminal is Kolkata Airport.
