The abstract should be anonymous and within maximum 500 words using 12 point TIMES NEW ROMAN with reasonable margins but without any extra lines in MS WORD Format. Selected paper presenters have to submit full paper in any language of the following five (maximum word limit 6000) along with the abstract (compulsory in English) by 20th February, 2015.

The seminar papers will be accepted in five languages: English, Hindi, Assamese, Bengali & Odia
