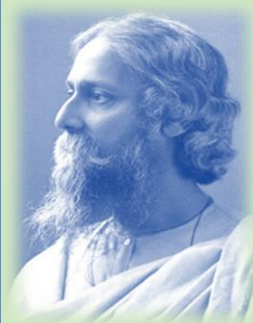

Abstract for presentations (within 300 words) may be submitted by e-mail to **ismpp.ezvb@gmail.com**. Abstract should be submitted in MS Word with Times New Roman & 1.5 spacing. Title: All capitals, bold, 16 pt; Author(s) Authors bold, 12 pt; Address: (11pt); E-mail: only one E-mail of Presenting author with asterisk superscript (*) should be provided. Abstract body: (12 pt); Keywords: upto 5 Nos. (12 pt).

GUIDELINE FOR POSTER PRESENTATION

The size of poster should be 3 ft (width) 4 ft (length). Poster should be legible from a distance of 1-2 m.
