



TENDER

The Pearson Memorial Hospital intends to enter into contracts for procuring of medicines for patients. Quotations are invited from different pharmaceutical company / supplier under following Terms & conditions.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT


1. Medicines will be purchased as per requirement from time to time. Drug molecules needed by the P M Hospital are mentioned in the annexure-1
2. Interested parties should quote the drug molecules into two bids. One envelop is for drug's generic name they intend to supply and second envelop should contain corresponding brand name and quoted price along with relevant papers. Envelops to be super scribed as generic name quotation & brand name along with price quotation accordingly.
3. The sealed tenders must reach / drop in the tender box kept at P M Hospital Office, Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan on or before 11-09-2018 within 5 pm.
4. Both the above envelops should be put in third envelop & super scribed "Quotation for Medicine Purchase for 2018-19". Also Company's Name / Agency's Name be mention in details on the envelop.
5. Validity of offer : The quotation should have validity for six month or more.
6. Medicines to be supplied with 80% shelf life.
7. The agent or company should have local Supplier / Distributors / Stockist Centre at Bolpur.
8. The bidder should submit-
 - a. Copy of Income Tax return for last two years.
 - b. Copy of PAN card/ Service Tax Registration.
 - c. Copy of Sales Tax/ VAT Registration certificate. *IGST Number*
 - d. The market standing of the firm should be at least 05 years in the field manufacturing/ marketing of medicine. The firm while applying for empanelment must enclose a certificate of the Drug Controller Certifying and Licensing Authority as per laid down proforma.
 - e. G M P Certificate.
 - f. I S O Certification.
 - g. The firm should submit a declaration that there was no punitive action taken against them by any Government Authority in the last five years.
9. If the product found to be sub standard quality, no payment will be made for the supplied medicines.



10. The place of supply is P M Hospital, Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan.
11. The price quotation should include carriage expenditure also.
12. P M Hospital purchase committee is not bound to accept the lowest of any tender and reserve the right to accept a tender in full or in part and/ or reject any tender in full or in part without assigning any reason thereof.

Our requirement quantity will vary from Rs 50,000 to 2 lakh per items.


