Dear Secretary,

Dr. Justice D.Y. Chandrachud, Hon'ble Judge, Supreme Court of India and Chairperson e-Committee has communicated to all the Chief Justices of the High Courts on 09.10.2021 urging them to ensure that e-filing of cases/petitions by the Government in all matters is made mandatory from 1st January, 2022 and that there should be no physical filing of cases by the Government in any matter thereafter.

- As a part of the digitization of courts in India, the system of e-filing and online payment of fees has been given a strong foundation and next step is to create an ICT enabled eco-system which supports digitized hearing to pave the way for digital and paperless courts. To ensure successful implementation of e-Courts Project, there is an urgent and definite need to make e-filing the standard norm.
- I am, therefore, to request you to take necessary steps and to also ensure mandatory e-filing in respect of litigation on behalf of Union of India by your Ministry/Department including Autonomous Bodies/Subordinate Offices/Attached Offices and PSUs under administrative control of your Ministry before the Courts across India w.e.f. 1st January, 2022.
