1. The benefit of Employees Provident Fund (EPF) scheme is extended to the enlisted casual workers who are presently working in various offices / departments of the University. The Accounts Officer is hereby requested to take necessary actions in this regard.
2. The enlisted casual workers may be re-engaged even after crossing the age of 60 years, for 6 months at a time, upto the age of 62 years subject to recommendation of the concerned heads of offices, after discontinuation of their engagements on attaining the age of 60 years.

This will come into immediate effect.
