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Intro

Professor Mohan Singh Khangura is a well known and reputed teacher and practitioner of several genres of <u>Indian Classical Vocal</u> music including Khayal, Thumary, Tappa, Dhrupada, Rabindra Sangeet, Sufi and folk music of his native state of Punjab. He has undergone extensive training under Ustads of the Agra, Vishnupur and Dagar traditions and *gharanas*.

Birrth & Education

Born in 1949 at Latala in Ludhinana district in Punjab in a family steeped in culture, tradition and music, he inherited his devotion to music from his father. After his initial education he came to Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan, to study at higher levels of music and did his Bachelor and Master of Music with flying colours. In Santiniketan he came under the sway of the great Guru Pandit Dhruva Tara Joshi, himself a disciple of the great Ustads Fayez Khan Saheb of Agra *gharana* and Inayat Hussain Khan of Gouripur *gharana*.

Awards

Professor Khangura has been variously honoured by many institutions and awards, including the President's Award in 2006. The most recent are:

In 2011 the Punjabi Academy of New Delhi felicitated him for his contribution to 'Punjabi Culture and Indian Music'. The award was handed over by the chief Minister of Delhi.

In May 2014 Asiatic Society awarded 'Rabindranath Tagore Birth Centenary Plaque' for the outstanding work constituting a creative contribution to human culture.

Recordings

Between 1994 and 2012 he has recorded and released sixteen cassettes and CDs on Indian Classical Vocals and Rabindra Sangeet (and a combination thereof) marketed by reputed Indian companies (such as HMV) which have been great sellers and have done very well in the regional, national and international markets: the most memorable being the six songs included as part of the 2007 HMV/SaReGaMa release *The Legends of Santiniketan* which also had songs sung by Rabindranath Tagore himself.

Public Performances

Mohan*da* – as he is fondly called by all and sundry in Santiniketan – has well over 350 public and semi-public performances, programmes, functions, solo recitals to his credit in India and abroad. His performances range from public dais solo function to corporate gala openings and programmes on All India Radio and Doordarshan and other private (music) television channels. As he is a celebrated academic and performer at Visva-Bharati, he has performed at various levels in almost all university programmes organised by Visva-Bharati on countless occasions.
