HISTORY OF THE DEPARTMENT

With an aim to promote the training, education and research in computer science in Visva-Bharati, the Department of Electronics, Govt. of India, approved a course on Diploma in Computer Application (DCA) which was introduced in the University in 1989, housed in the Computer Centre and was initially offered by the joint Boards of Studies of Departments of Physics and Mathematics, Institute of Science in 1992. The course, subsequently, was upgraded to Master of Computer Application (MCA) and the Department of Computer and System Sciences formally came into being since July 1998 with the responsibility of offering it. With the passage of time the department grew gradually with its own Board of Studies, initiating and offering programmes such as B. Sc and Ph. D both in Computer Science since 2002 and 2004 respectively. M. Sc in Computer Science was initiated since 2005 setting behind the MCA programme.
