HISTORY OF THE CENTRE

The centre was established in the year 2008 on the recommendation of a high-level committee appointed by The Paridarśaka (Visitor) of Visva-Bharati and The President of India in 2006. The Five-Year Integrated M.Sc. programme was started in 2009 with Physics, Chemistry and Mathematics and over the time expanded to offer Life Science as well as Earth and Environmental Science as major subjects. The centre was shifted to its new building in 2014 and its infrastructure has been developing continuously since then. Presently it is a DST-FIST supported centre with advanced research facilities.

PROGRAMMES AND COURSES OFFERED

The centre offers Five-Year Integrated M.Sc. programme with the aim for teaching Physics, Chemistry, Mathematics and Life Science with equal emphasis during the first two years and then the students opt for their major subjects in any of the four subjects as well as Earth and Environmental Science. Apart from that, the centre also offers Ph.D. programme on the aforementioned five broad areas.
