PROGRAMME:

Inauguration of Nagchampatala open-air stage and book-fair

1 December 2014

The inaugural ceremony of open-air stage 'Nagchampatala' along with a book-fair, was held at Visva-Bharati Granthana Vibhaga, Kolkata on 1 December 2014. The 'Nagchampa' tree was garlanded by Professor Sushanta Dattagupta, Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor of Visva-Bharati, with chanting from the Upanishad. Dr Ramkumar Mukhopadhyay, Director, Visva-Bharati Granthana Vibhaga, Prof Indrani Mukhopadhyay, Provost, Rabindrasangeet Gabeshana Kendra and Sri Avik Ghosh, Adhyapak, Sikshasatra also garlanded the tree. It was followed by the inauguration of the book-fair with the lighting of the ceremonial lamp.

Professor Sushanta Dattagupta in his inaugural speech mentioned that the Nagchampa tree facing the stage was grown sometimes in the 20's of the last century as said by the elderly people. He added that the Nagchampa tree belonging to the genus of Ochrocarpus Thouars is called in various names as Nagkesar, Punnaga etc. He expressed his pleasure that the stage is named after the tree and discussed how the friendship between Gurudev and Jagadish Chandra Bose brought literature and science close to each other. Professor Indrani Mukhopadhyay, Provost, Rabindrasangeet Gabesana Kendra highlighted the new research activities in the centre which would develop a number of manuscripts for the Granthana Vibhaga to publish. Professor Samik Bandopadhyay remarked how Professor Asin Dasgupta in the early 90's as the Vice-Chancellor of the Visva-Bharati tried to bring the Granthana Vibhaga out of the copyright protection to compete with international publishing houses.

Dr Ramkumar Mukhopadhyay mentioned some of the new initiatives of the Granthana Vibhaga like publishing all the 134 titles of the Visva-Vidya series in a 21 volume project, translating Tagore's selected writings into English in three volumes, publishing Gitanjali in tribal languages, attending book-fairs outside the state etc.

Smt Arpita Dutta, Sri Prasanta Kumar Ghosh and Smt Manini Mukhopadhyay, all faculty members of the Sangita Bhavana presented Rabindrasangit.

Book release programme

A book release programme was held infront of Sriniketan Griha, Santiniketan on 23 December 2014. The welcome address was given by Professor Tapati Mukhopadhyay, Provost, Culture and Cultural relations, who dwelt on Kalanukramik Rabindra Rachanabali with Sri Gautam Bhattacharya, Executive editor of Visva-Bharati.
