Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel's Birth Anniversary Celebration at Granthana Vibhaga

7 November 2014, Kolkata

A symposium on Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the great freedom fighter and one of the makers of Modern India, was organized at the Sabhaghar of the Visva-Bharati Granthana Vibhaga, Kolkata, on 7 November 2014.

He is remembered as an important leader who is known for his effort to unite a scattered nation without any bloodshed. About his strength of character it is often said that Sardar Patel showed the defiance of the oppressed, brilliance of a lawyer, the strategy of a General, the generosity of the strong, the firmness of a patriot and the farsightedness of a statesman.
