Terms of Reference (ToR)

Visva-Bharati Decade Mission 2035

The dynamic landscape of higher education requires universities to adopt forward-looking strategies to remain relevant, competitive, impactful and upholding its tradition. To this end, Visva-Bharati is establishing a **Decade Mission 2035** committee to develop a comprehensive and strategic vision policy as a higher educational institution.

Purpose

- Define the long-term aspirations of the university.
- Provide strategic direction for academic, research, innovation, infrastructure, and community engagement.
- Align with national and international standards and best practices in higher education.
- Serve as a guiding document for policy development, strategic planning, and decision-making.

Objectives

- Assess the current status, strengths, challenges, and opportunities of the university.
- Conduct stakeholder consultations, including faculty, students, alumni, industry, and government representatives.
- Benchmark the university's vision against global best practices and peer institutions.
- Propose a clear, realistic, and inspiring vision statement.
- Recommend strategic goals and key thematic focus areas.

Thematic Area of Focus of the University

- Yoga and Indian Knowledge System
- Digitization and e-Governance
- PPP of Hospital
- Green Initiative
- Rural Reconstruction- Adoption of more than 100 villages
- Develop Strategies for National and International MoU

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Scope of Work

- Review existing institutional policies and strategic documents.
- Analyze national education policies, such as the National Education Policy (NEP) and ITEP etc.
- Prepare pictorial design, flowchart, bullet points and block diagrams depicting the vision and policy.
- Draft and finalize the Vision Policy Document, incorporating feedback from internal and external stakeholders.
- Submit the final document to the appropriate university authorities for approval.

Roles and Responsibilities

- **Chairperson:** Provide overall leadership, ensure quality and progress.
- **Convener:** Convene meetings Manage documentation, communications, and scheduling.
- **Members:** Participate in discussions, contribute ideas, engage stakeholders, and review drafts.

Reporting and Deliverables

- **Interim Report(s):** Updates on progress and preliminary findings.
- **Final Deliverable:** Vision Policy Document with:
 - Vision and mission statements
 - Strategic focus areas and goals
 - Implementation roadmap
 - Summary of stakeholder inputs
 - Publication of Policy Document

Meetings: The committee shall meet at regular intervals (at least once a month or as needed). Additional committee meetings may be held for specialized areas.

Review and Approval: The Vision Policy Document for the next 10 years (**Vision Visva-Bharati 2035**), once finalized, will be submitted to the **Vice Chancellor** for discussion and formal adoption.
