Ashok Rudra (1930-1992) was an economist of international stature, a classical scholar and a "public intellectual". He conducted many pioneering studies on India's economy and society. Rudra's professional writings challenged established theories and conventional wisdom. He frequently intervened intrepidly in public debates. Rudra wrote prolifically on literary and cultural issues, and was a recognised eminent writer in Bengali. Few Indian economists achieved this remarkable blend of technique, scholarship and creativity. Professor Rudra was attached to Visva-Bharati as a Professor of Economics from 1968-1973 and again from 1979-1990.



Prabhat Patnaik is one of India's most eminent economists. He has a PhD from Oxford University where he was a Rhodes Scholar from India. He was on the faculty of Cambridge University for some years before he returned to become the Sukhamoy Chakravarti Professor of Economics at Jawaharlal Nehru University in New Delhi. He is the author of several books, including Accumulation and Stability under Capitalism, Time, Inflation and Growth, Macroeconomics, Economics and Egalitarianism, The Value of Money, etc. He is the recipient of many honors and awards and has an honorary degree from the School of Oriental and African Studies (SOAS), London University. He served as the Vice-Chairman of the Kerala State Planning Board.
