Then browse a) download Cisco Webex (as confirm by the host through mail) (<http://www.webex.co.in>) for Desktop / Laptop or webex App from the Play store for smart phone. or b) 'saynamaste' (<http://www.saynamaste.in>) through browser, as communicated from library side. The link (including ID and Password) for joining of the each session will be sent just 8-10 hours before the session.

With the above mentioned ID and Password candidate needs to join the meeting just 20mins before the session to avoid last minute rush.

This may noted that only 100 candidates will be allowed to participate in the meeting on the basis of the first-cum-first joining basis. Others may not be allowed to join. But, those will not attend the program the video of the program will be made available through 'vlibnet facebook'. If require, session may be repeated based on the number of non-participating candidates.

After joining in the meeting, to conduct the session noise-free all participants invariably mute their audio till the speech is over. During question answering session after the speech they may un-mute their audio and ask the question, then again put mute.

Please do not ping through WhatsApp or ring through Mobile to host for unable to join and any other reason to offer safe environment to the host to arrange the session properly. Everything will be visible to him who is able to join and who is not; based on the capacity host will do the needful to allow to join the participants in the session.

Other than VB fraternity may attend the session which are marked as 'B' and 'C' only, but not allowed for the sessions marked for 'A'.
