






Gender Ratio: Admitted Students in BPA: 2024



Dancing with Time: Building Vocabularies from the Past and the Present

In India dance forms and their pedagogies would resemble a complex riverine system if they are mapped over the geo-political region. Uniqueness of forms coexist with overlapping histories, local material cultures and musical instruments coexist with sharing of contexts/ stories and myths, classical dances and dancers represent the nation state in global events while proudly representing their specific regions and cultures.

The traditional practices continue side by side with the teaching and performance of classical dances and experimental creative works popularly known as the contemporary dance.


Learning of specialized dance forms in India starts early in childhood with master-teachers, as a parallel activity to school education and each of the master-teachers (identified as 'Guru') usually teaches a specific style, and the student begins to carry that signature style as an identifiable marker in his/her performance very early in his/her career.

In such a circumstance, institutions of higher education have often debated about the unlearning it forces its students to go through during their pursuit of the higher degrees in dance. However, what remains most important in degrees in dance in India is the training in individual as well as ensemble choreographic work and overall presentational quality alongside an overview of the dance ecology in the country.

Dance history is already thought to be important and excepted as a part of the syllabus in dance departments. I urge that we work for a broadening of the horizon with the possible inclusion of critical dance studies in the specific context of Indian dance in dance degree courses. It is important to create a course structure that helps the students and scholars to see dance — not only as a tool for entertainment and aesthetic rendition, but also for understanding its functions and importance in education, socialization, occupational pursuits, identity assertions and maintenance of cohesion. The importance of understanding the connection between performing arts in general and dance in particular to production of identity, and assertions of caste, class, regionality, gender, ethnic identity and religious specificity cannot be emphasized enough in the current times. The contemporary concerns within the dance ecology compels dancers to engage in new ways with embodied perspectives. Hence departments of higher education need to keep up with the changing discourse.

There are many new publications on dance studies, and new research perspectives are broadening the horizon of critical research in many new departments teaching practice & theory interface in dance degree courses. included a number of essays on the issue of searching for newer directions for dance, by eminent dancers and scholars. New dance, new

writings, decontextualized spaces of performance and new patronage is challenging older pedagogies as well as frameworks of categorization of dances into 'folk', indigenous, tribal, popular, classical, modern etc. In these times, one recalls scholar Kapila *Vatyayan's* observation in Sunil Kothari's edited book *New Directions in Indian Dance* (Marg. 2003), "The classification of *nritta*, pure dance and abhinaya, expressional dance is no longer relevant, nor sometimes the sequential storyline." (Vatsyayan, 2003: 30 – 31). But dance as a cultural and embodied knowledge remains relevant. It also continues to be important as an occupation, as a tool for framing and asserting individual and collective identity and an artistic expression for exploring aesthetic constructions of the sociocultural universe. In these changing times university courses in dance matter more than ever before. Let us all work for building a space that helps the new dancers and dance scholars to realize their potentials, voice their doubts and questions, realize their creative agency and dance to their heart's content.
