Sir / Madam,

Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) including Centrally funded Institutes (CFIs) holds seminars, conferences, workshops and other events at regular intervals and on such occasions, the guests / dignitaries are usually felicitated by presenting them with shawl / angavastram / bouquet / potted plants etc.

In this connection, it is suggested that in keeping with the thrust on Aatmanirbhar Bharat (Self-reliant India), khadi products such as Angavastram, shawl etc. which are eco-friendly may increasingly be used for felicitation purposes. Such a practice while reaffirming our links with freedom struggle, also showcases our appreciation to our nation's rich textile tradition. Similarly, books may also be considered for presentation on such occasions to reflect our commitment to knowledge and learning and as a way to disseminate our rich literary culture to a wider audience.
