A walk-in interview will be held in the office of the Principal, Siksha-Bhavana, Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan-731235 on 16/07/2019, at 11:30 A.M. to recruit one Junior Research Fellow (JRF) to work in a DBT funded multi-centric Network research project with The University of Burdwan [No. BT/PR28574/AAQ/3/920/2018, date 18/06/2019] entitled "Prebiotic feed supplement for growth improvement of Indian major carps, *Labeo rohita*, *Cirrhinus mrigala* and *Catla catla* under composite culture system: A gut microbiome and nutrigenomics based approach" under the supervision of Dr. Bomba Dam (P.I), Department of Botany, Visva-Bharati.

Qualifications for JRF: The candidates must have qualified M.Sc. with minimum 55% marks in Botany, Zoology, Microbiology, Biotechnology or related Life Sciences subjects. In addition they are required to qualify any of the national level eligibility test for research like CSIR-UGC NET (JRF or LS), GATE, or any such exam conducted by Govt. of India agencies like DBT, DST, ICAR, ICMR, DAE, MHRD, IIT, IISER, IISc, DOS, DRDO etc as specified in the DST OM No. SR/S9/Z-08/2018. Fellowship: Rs. 31,000 per month + HRA (@ 8%) for the first and second year and Rs. 35,000 per month + HRA (@ 8%) for the third year.

Age: Not more than 28 years (relaxable up to 5 years for SC/ST/OBC/PH/Woman candidate)

Duration: Tenure is expected to be three years / terminate with termination of the project

Applications on a plain paper with self-attested copy of all academic documents have to be submitted on the date of interview.

Candidates have to produce original documents during the interview.
