Brahma mandir, Santiniketan

Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore established a different kind of education centre at Santiniketan that started with a school in 1902 and became recognized as a Central University in 1951 by the Government of India. Santiniketan is the place of two distinguished Nobel laureates of Asia: Rabindranath Tagore (first from Asia), the founder of Visva-Bharati and Amartya Sen, the Nobel Prize winner in Economics, 1998. Its peaceful and serene setting is strikingly picturesque, with lush green trees, red soil, and a distinct architectural style, preserved its village character.

About Department of Zoology

The Department of Zoology, under Siksha-Bhavana (Institute of Science) is one among the few Centres of academic excellence at Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan. 1. Word limit: 250 words (Excluding Title, Authors, and Affiliations) 2. Font: Times New Roman (12 size, Title in Bold) 3. Author's Name: Full Names, Name of the presenting author should be underlined. 4. Affiliations: Complete Address of the institute. 5. Email: Email is of the presenting author.

Abstract structure:

All abstracts should be structured as follows:

1. Background: should very briefly indicate the purpose and objective of the research.
2. Methods: should include clear, concise descriptions of experiments performed, including the controls used for the study and methods of analysis used.
3. Results: should present the experimental data.
4. Conclusions: should summarize the study based on the results, with future implications, if any.
