Applications are invited from Indian nationals to work as a Junior Research Fellow under the SERB funded project: 'Study of scalar perturbations in cosmological models of Dark Energy' (Sanction No: EMR/2016/007162) under the supervision of Dr. Sudipta Das, Principal Investigator, Department of Physics, Visva-Bharati, Santiniketan. Candidates should have M.Sc. in Physics with minimum 55% marks and NET and/or GATE qualification and age below 28 years at the time of application (relaxable as per the norms/orders of Government of India). Salary: Rs. 25000 + HRA (as per DST guidelines).

The tenure of the project is 3 years. The post is purely temporary and co-terminus with the duration of the project. Candidate selected for this position can also apply for the regular PhD program of Visva-Bharati provided the candidate satisfy the eligibility criteria.
