Profile Sajad Hamdani was born in 1971 in Srinagar, Kashmir. He draws inspiration from his childhood experiences with the gigantic maple trees and freshwater lakes of his homeland. His work also reflects the political violence that has been prevalent in the region. He describes his art as a process, stating that "The process is a never ending creation and can be pursued to be as large as one can imagine the idea is between the relation of one object to another". A self-taught painter, he began his artistic journey in 1987 at the age of 16. He created a significant body of work before joining his BFA course and often sold his paintings to support his studies. After his BFA, he taught as an art teacher at Delhi Public School, Jammu, before pursuing his MFA in sculpture at Visva-Bharati University. He was the first student to apply to Kala Bhavana since its establishment and was admitted on merit. He received merit scholarships for both years of his MFA and graduated with a first-class first. He found Santiniketan to be a productive and formative period, where he realized that a conducive atmosphere, in addition to skills and intellectual pursuits, is essential for an artist. During his time there, he worked with ideas closely related to nature and the local tropical environment, utilizing materials such as trees, weeds, and grass. After completing his masters, he taught art for a year and a half at the Roong-Aroon School in Bangkok, Thailand.
