ABOUT THE WORKSHOP

This 3-day workshop focuses on reviving and integrating Indian Knowledge Systems (IKS) in livestock management by bringing together farmers, practitioners, academicians, and veterinarians. It highlights the value of indigenous livestock practices—from ethnoveterinary medicine and traditional feeding systems to climate-resilient management and conservation of native breeds. The program combines expert lectures with hands-on training, live demonstrations, farm visits, and case studies. Targeting approximately 30 participants, the workshop aims to enhance awareness, promote sustainable and low-cost practices, encourage the documentation of traditional knowledge, and foster synergy between traditional wisdom and modern animal husbandry.

LOCATION AND CLIMATE

Visva-Bharati is situated in rural West Bengal, about 160 km from Kolkata. The nearest railway station is Bolpur (Santiniketan), located 5 km from the campus, with trains taking approximately two hours to reach from Kolkata. The nearest airport is in Kolkata. December weather is mildly cool and comfortable, with temperatures ranging from a low of around 11-13°C (51-55°F) to a high of 26-27°C (79-81°F)

ABOUT PALLI-SIKSHA BHAVANA

Palli-Siksha Bhavana (Institute of Agriculture), established in 1963, offers undergraduate (B.Sc. Ag.) and postgraduate (M.Sc. Ag.) programmes across major agricultural disciplines, along with Ph.D. research facilities. The institute integrates teaching, research, and extensive agricultural extension activities. Key academic components include RAWE and Experiential Learning. It is supported by farms, laboratories, library, RKVK, and a Placement Cell, with limited hostel accommodation available.
