An application is invited for a short-term (2 months) Research Internship/Training under the ANRF-sponsored Major Research Project (CRG/2023/002389 dated 06/03/2024) entitled "*Characterization of molecular candidates regulating ovulatory response vis-à-vis oocyte bioenergetics in zebrafish: susceptibility to environmental contaminants*"* under the supervision of **Prof. Sudipta Maitra, Department of Zoology, Visva-Bharati.**
