

Report on Inauguration of Security Club

The Security Club of students was successfully inaugurated at PSV, Sriniketan under Visva-Bharati on 1st April 2026 at 4:30 pm in the Conference Hall of the Department of Social Work. The program was organized to promote awareness about campus safety and to encourage students to take responsibility for maintaining a secure environment.
