

Industry Visit

Jaya Shree Textiles, Rishra, West Bengal

Jaya Shree Textiles, located in Rishra, West Bengal, is a pioneer in the Indian textile industry, specialising in linen production, and is also one of the country's major wool manufacturers using modern technology and expertise to transform wool fibres into luxurious wool tops and yarns.

An industrial visit was organised

on 31st August 2026 to provide students with first-hand knowledge and practical exposure to textile manufacturing practices followed in the industry.



The visit began with an introductory session in which the students were briefed on safety aspects and the zero-liquid-discharge (ZLD) concept, followed by an industry visit. Md. Amiruddin Hawari, Assistant Manager-HR, provided an overview of manufacturing activities, the product range, global market presence, and the importance of natural fibres in the industry. He also explained the process sequences used for linen and wool fibres, and during the plant visit, students observed how raw flax and wool fibres are converted into yarn.

Sri Suranjan Das, Assistant Manager of the Yarn Dyeing Department and an alumnus of Silpa-Sadana, Visva-Bharati, elaborated on the yarn dyeing process in the industrial set-up, laboratory dyeing methods, and



the automatic colour measurement system. Kumari Anushka, Officer, Fabric Design, and an alumnus of Silpa-Sadana, Visva-Bharati, described various aspects of the industry and its activities.

This industrial visit successfully bridged the gap between academic learning and industrial practice, providing students with firsthand knowledge of textile manufacturing, industrial safety, sustainable practices adopted in textile chemical processing, and career opportunities in the textile sector. Students can relate theoretical and practical classroom studies to their real-world industrial applications. The visit also encouraged observation, communication, discipline, and professional interaction with industry experts. Department of Silpa-Sadana is very much grateful to the management of Jaya Shree Textiles for their warm hospitality and support in making this industry visit a success.
