Dear Sir,

We are glad to inform you that Prof. R. Siva Kumar, Professor of History of Art, Kala Bhavana, Visva Bharati, Santiniketan, has been selected for deputation as the Visiting Professor to ICCR Chair of Indian Studies at Carleton University, Canada, for a period of one semester commencing from 1st week of January, 2018. The terms and conditions of your deputation would be as follows:-

a. <u>Tenure:-</u> The period of deputation will commence from the date he joins the University and ends on the day he is relieved from the institute. The deputationist is entitled for the preparation/ joining time of up to 7 days at the time of commencement and completion of tenure, during which he should report to ICCR to sign his joining report/relieving report. If there is any gap between the date of signing the joining report/ relieving report and joining his parent University, it should be regularized by the latter under applicable rules.

b. Obligations:-

- (i) Obligation of Prof. R. Siva Kumar will be in accordance with the MoU signed between ICCR and Carleton University, Canada.
- (ii) Prof. R. Siva Kumar will teach course at the Carleton University in consultation with the Carleton University, Canada.
- (iii) Prof. R. Siva Kumar will finalize the curriculum/course in consultation with the Carleton University, Canada.
- (iv) Prof. R. Siva Kumar will deliver at least one public lecture during the semester to be arranged by the University, which would be termed as "ICCR Lecture on India".

- (v) Conduct and performance:- The Visiting Professor will abide by the host University's code of conduct and human resources policies and laws of the country for deputation.
- (vi) Employment of Spouse and Family members:- The spouse of Prof. R. Siva Kumar and dependent family members if residing with him shall not accept any employment in Canada, on payment basis without prior permission of the ICCR, who will consider such proposals only if recommended by the concerned Mission/Post and in consultation with the Ministry of External Affairs, when necessary. (Note- All expenditure on accompanying spouse and family members will be borne by Prof. R. Siva Kumar himself.)

c. Pay & other remuneration payable by ICCR:-

- (i) During the period of deputation, Prof. R. Siva Kumar will draw from the relevant Mission/Post the same basic pay and grade pay as is being drawn by him in the present scale of pay in parent organization, with annual increments to the next higher stages in the scale.
- (ii) No other allowance, including deputation duty allowance, servant wages EWF charges, will be admissible.
- (iii) The Quantum of Additional Allowance admissible will be determined on the basis of the country of deputation. The Quantum of Additional Allowance once fixed, will remain unchanged for the duration of the deputation and will not be affected by any revision of pay scales/grade pay on account of annual increment, promotion or grant of ACPs or any other factors.
- (iv) Further, the amount/honorarium being paid by the University under the MoU with ICCR would be deposit in the Mission.
- (v) Grant of leave will be regulated in terms of relevant provisions of IFS (PLCA) Rules.
- (vi) Prof. R. Siva Kumar will not accept any other remuneration other than as provided in this letter and in the MoU while on deputation.
- d. <u>Pension/Provident Fund</u>:- During the period of deputation, Prof. R.Siva Kumar will continue to be governed by the rules of the Visva Bharati, Santiniketan, West Bengal, relating to the pension/provident fund etc. The Mission/Post will remit employers subscription to the provident fund by RBI drafts through deduction from the monthly salary bill to his parent institution under intimation to the ICCR.


f. Passage & Baggage Allowance:-

- i. Settlement of final dues:- The final dues on his return will be settled only after receiving Performance/Assessment Report from the concerned University and the Mission.
- j. Recall:- If circumstances arise which necessitate termination of appointment of Prof. R. Siva Kumar the decision thereof would be taken by ICCR in consultation with the Carleton University, Canada.
- Any matter not covered above will be referred to ICCR whose decision will be final.

The appointment will be subject to the formal acceptance of the terms and conditions of the offer detailed in this letter by Prof. R. Siva Kumar with the formal concurrence of his parent institution. Prof. R. Siva Kumar is required to join the ICCR in January, 2018. However, the exact date from which his services are required will be intimated in due course on receipt of concurrence from him.
