Opening remarks of the Chairman:

- (1) The Chairman warmly welcomed the Hon'ble External Member of Academic Council, Mr. P.K. Basu, IAS, Member, CAT and former Secretary, Govt. of India and all the members attending this meeting of Academic Council.
- (2) The Upacharya mentioned with glory for some of the prestigious achievements of Visva-Bharati in the recent past. These include:
 - (a) Obtaining of 19th Place of Visva-Bharati in the national level NIRF Ranking.
 - (b) Subsequent announcement of the Hon'ble HRD Minister on the achievement of Cashless transaction drive, Visva-Bharati initiated Vittiya Saksharata Abhiyan (VISAKA) and ranked 10th among 3500 institutions in the VISAKA Cashless Drive.

- (c) Visva-Bharati is moving rapidly towards digitization in academic and administrative ventures. Choice Based Credit System (CBCS) course curricula have already been introduced in Visva-Bharati and the University, in accordance with UGC's SWAYAM Regulation 2016 is considering for offering the online courses (MOOCs).
- (d) The University is ready to provide Degree/Diploma Certificates online through National Academic Depository (NAD) Portal, as proposed by the MHRD.

- (h) We expect that the next Convocation of the University will be held soon. The faculty members may send names for the prestigious Desikottama Award, Gagan-Aban Puraskar and Rathindra Puraskar.

Teachers' Achievements:

- (1) Dr. Alakananda Hazra, Assistant Professor, Department of Chemistry has got the prestigious Bronze Medal from the Chemical Research Society of India (CRSI) for his contribution to research in Chemistry.

The Faculty member, who has been quoted in the news report mentioned indicates a bad taste. The house

condemns such act of spreading disparaging statements in media. The house also express their concern as to how a faculty members of V.B. can give press statements without the permission of the Administration in General. As discussion proceeds the members find enough justification and Academic needs in reviving the age old dairy farm at Sriniketan besides the revival of Gurudev's dream of having a good dairy farm at Sriniketan. All the B.Sc.(Ag.) Hons. and M.Sc.(Ag.) students, which is about four hundred (400) in number (approximately 65 \times 04 = 260 B.Sc.(Ag.) Hons. students and 70 \times 02 = 140 M.Sc.(Ag.) students), need their training on how to handle Cows and how to manage a dairy farm along with other agriculture related issues in order to get their degree accredited by the Indian Council of Agricultural Research (ICAR), the Apex body for approving any degree in Agriculture. Some learned members also expressed their experience of visiting Universities abroad and Stated that a good dairy farm is an asset to a University and University can earn good revenue by selling dairy products. It has also been agreed by the members of the Academic Council that the matter related to the purchase of Cows for dairy farm is neither a matter to be discussed nor a matter to be approved in the Academic Council and the Executive Council meetings.

The meeting ended with a vote of thanks to the chair.

The house observed one-minute silence in the memory of the departed souls. The Academic Council (Siksha-Samiti) puts on record its profound sense of grief and condolences to the members of the bereaved families.

The meeting started with opening song from the Upanishada.

Introductory remarks of the Chairman:

The Vice Chancellor and Chairman, Academic Council (Siksha-Samiti) made a few introductory remarks before taking up the agenda.

A. Progress Report:

1. The Hon'ble Vice President of India, Mr. Venkaiah Naidu visited Santiniketan on 16th August, 2019 and rededicated 'Shyamali' the historic mud house at Rabindra-Bhavana

- after its renovation by Archeological Survey of India(ASI) to the nation. He made a short visit this time and assured to visit Santiniketan again for a longer period.
- 2. He told that as per announcement in the previous meeting, this meeting of the Academic Council (Siksha-Samiti) meeting will be held paperless. This is unique for the University to conduct such a large meeting paperless in order to save paper, ink etc.
- 3. He explained the financial position of the University. He mentioned that the University has no resources on its own to undertake any development work particularly, the repairing works of the Academic Building. In order to overcome the situation, the University applied for loan through HEFA and Rs. 68 Crores have been sanctioned to the University for the purpose. Efforts have been made to get financial support from financial institutions like State Bank of India, Axix Bank, Bandhan Bank, Yes Bank, ONGC, V.B. Co-operative Credit Society etc. and some assistance has been received.
- 4. He mentioned that functions and cultural activities are being observed as scheduled. He mentioned that 25th Baisakha, 22nd Sravana and Rabindra Saptaha have been observed and Saradotsava is going on.
- 5. Convocation of the University has been proposed to be held in the last week of November or first week of December this year. The exact date will be finalized upon confirmation by the Hon'ble Prime Minister of India, Mr. Narendra Modi who is the Chancellor of Visva-Bharati and Hon'ble President of India, Mr. Ramnath Kobind, who is the Paridarsaka(Visitor) of the University. Efforts are on to have both of them this time.
- 6. The Chinese Consulate General in Kolkata has agreed for Officers' Exchange Programme with Visva-Bharati and a few Universities of China. This is a new approach and till date only teachers and students are covered in educational exchange programme. Total (Eighteen)18 Officers including Joint Registrars, Deputy Registrars, and Assistant Registrars will visit China for the purpose and the first batch officers is expected to vist in November. 2019.
- 7. The Chairman has also informed the house that he has visited Bangladesh and China and delivered lectures. During his visit to Bangladesh, Visva-Bharati has signed a MoU (Memorandum of Understanding) with National University of Gazipur, Bangladesh.

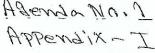
