Artist's statement with Area of expertise:

My work is a conscious expression of the real and unreal. The inner of human persona is a matter that happens to be way beyond our realms of imagination. His natural psyche, their obvious complexities, primal dualities, not to mention carnal torment of eroticism is never expressed in reality. The enclosed mental state, the melancholia, mediocrity and even perversion articulated here in the form of almost comical disguise.

I often use grotesque and satirical exaggeration as a tool to reflect the innermost psychological state of the mind. In order to capture the multi-layered interpretation of human expressions, the images appear and reappear in multiple identities, in unexpected, informal manner. The distorted gestures, exaggerated postures, and grotesque features are emphasized by their usually cheerful and vigorous enthusiasm, within, their rather beautified, dreamy and decorative surroundings.

Each human being is an embodiment of several person, what interests me most is that the way these different persona surfaces in a different situation. While questioning the implied morality within the social system, my focus plays around satire, comic and grotesque in order to express larger social condition. To question the value system set by the society which is often dominated by gender power or social hierarchy. The duality of human behaviour, between embracing the ugly side of life and at the same time criticising the institutions that create this ugliness, and between creating social commentary while not advocating action.

As a figurative painter I enjoy using different body gestures to express what I want to say through my work, the drama which can be created by figures in space, to animate the mind of my characters, with a generous dose of humor. Occasionally suggesting the animalistic desire and extravagance that are obvious element of human condition, apparently obscured but often make appearances in their varied metamorphosed aspects.
